In my photographs I've captured the elements of daily life, the elements in a visited land and a sense of the seasons. On reflection, I realised that these images were unconsciously connected to water, which can be seen in the snow, ice, fog, lakes sea, rain, the water of the swimming pool, the aquarium, water in a glass. Even when its shape and color change physically, they are all H2O. I like water. This is when my interest in water began. I wanted to explore the relationship between water and us as human beings. Water is essential. for all creatures on earth. Water changes shape, it's sometimes dangerous, but tender, cold, and hot. Water can sustain life, but it also has the power to kill us. I find water mysterious, beautiful, mesmerizing, and marvelous. The relationship between water and light, between water and creatures, between water and everything, is fascinating. This exhibition is the first step in understanding these relationships. I would like to expand my research on water and the environment in the future, and explore its complexity. This time, I will mainly exhibit work from "still, quiet, white H2O".
